Algebraic reasoning in 3- to 5-year-olds

For example, for any given set of objects with numerosity x , x changes whenever an object is added to or subtracted from the set; this knowledge applies regardless of what numerosity x refers to Thus, whether the set contains 1, 5, or 100 objects, when an object is added to the set, the numerosity has increased
